Plus we've got some great offers, just for our residents, including free theatre tickets and free pet microchipping (see page 3)

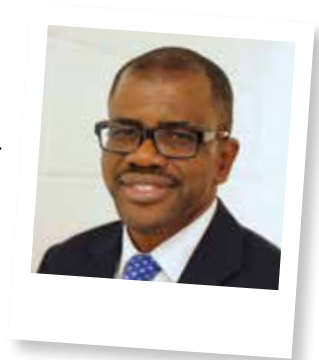

From April this year it became law for dogs to be microchipped and their details registered on an authorised database. A microchip allows lost or stolen pets to be identified and returned to their owner.

At The Scruffs Dog Show on Saturday 18 June between 1 – 4pm at Brunswick Park in Camberwell, London, SE5 you can benefit from FREE microchipping, neutering and healthcheck vouchers for your dog.

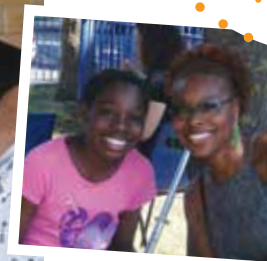

Plus with Universal Credit applications having to be made and managed online it is crucial that more people know how to use IT confidently.

Money matters

There are lots of major changes taking place to welfare benefits and it's important that you understand how you and your family will be affected.



One of the major changes to the benefits system is the introduction of Universal Credit.

Universal Credit rolls together six benefits into one monthly payment. It is designed to support people who are on a low income or out of work, and it will be rolled out in Peckham Ward in October/November this year.

As Universal Credit will be paid directly into your bank account, you will be responsible for budgeting your money, paying your bills and making sure your rent is paid on time. It's a good idea to set up a Direct Debit or Standing Order so that your rent is paid automatically each month and you won't have to worry about missing a payment. For more information about the changes to the welfare system, or for confidential advice on budgeting and managing your money, please pop into our office for a chat.

Keep it down!

Please be aware of your noise levels, especially during the summer months when people leave their windows open. If you are having a bbq or get together please keep the music down and make sure you and your guests don't disturb your neighbours. Noise nuisance is a form of antisocial behaviour and together with Southwark Council, we can and will take action against you if you breach your tenancy agreement.

Your rent pays for important services and improvements to your homes and neighbourhood so it's crucial that you pay in full, and on time. With lots of different ways to pay, it's easier than ever to keep your account up to date:

- **Direct Debit or Standing Order**
the easiest and most convenient way to pay. Contact your housing officer on 0203 643 6941 to obtain the necessary forms and never worry about missing a payment again.
- **Online**
visit www.southwark.gov.uk/payforit and make a payment from the comfort of your own home
- **Post**
cheque or postal order (made payable to Southwark Council)
- **Telephone**
call 0845 6000 611 and pay by credit or debit card. Lines are open 24 hours a day 7 days a week.
- **Customer payment swipe card**
use at a Post Office or any shop displaying the Pay Point sign. If you haven't got a Swipe Card talk to your Income Officer.
